# PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

- Helmet
- Hood
- Mask
- Coat
- Pants
- Boots
- Gloves
- SCBA



60 second requirement: to get a certification in PPE a firefighter has to be able to put all this gear on and have it ready to go in 60 seconds.

# CPR, AED, and First Aid Certification

- Basic safety training required for all firefighters
- Knowing these basic skills can help save someone's life

# SCBA (Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus)

- Drills - Basic requirements for the SCBA
  - Put it on in 60 seconds.
- Protects your face and lungs from toxic smoke and extreme heat
- It is important to be able to use this equipment quickly
- A fire doubles in size every 60 seconds



# Truck Check

- Cleaning and checking all tools and equipment on the trucks because everything needs to be ready to go in a moment's notice.
- Checking supplies
- Cleaning tools
- Starting and maintaining all small engines



# Hose Deployment and Use

Attack Hose: Used for offensive and defensive firefighting.

Supply Hose: Used to supply trucks with high amounts of water

Deck Gun: Used for high flow fire attack in residential or high rise buildings.



# Forest Fire Training

- Hand Tools: Used to cut fire lines and contain small fires.
- Portable Pumps: Used in remote places with bodies of water to pump water through fire hoses.
- Small Diameter Hose: Used in mop up operations.



# Forest Fire PPE

- Leather gloves
- Leather boots
- Nomex pants
- Nomex shirt
- Helmet
- Goggles
- Fire blanket used for fire fighting crews who get overrun or are surrounded by a fire
- Blanket is a last resort for fire fighters to protect themselves





# Fireground Strategy

- Car is approached from a diagonal direction
- Minimizes chance of injury due to:
  - Tire blow up or
  - Exploding oil shocks on bumpers
